The Cabbage Patch College Scholars Program

During the 2024-2025 academic year, 39 motivated Cabbage Patch Scholars received \$281,000* in scholarships that help bridge the financial gap often created after student loans and grants have been applied toward college tuition, housing, fees and expenses. Personal attention and support are provided to each Cabbage Patch College Scholar throughout their college career, greatly increasing their likelihood of graduation.

*This includes \$107,000 in Cabbage Patch funding; \$105,000 through a partnership with the University of Kentucky (a minimum of \$2,500 per student in annually renewable scholarships); \$20,000 through the Mackin Family Foundation; \$49,000 via the Carl Pollard Scholarship at the University of Louisville (\$14,000 annually per scholar).
